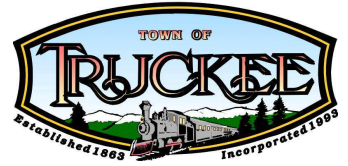

The Community Spay/Neuter Program is a subsidized
program to spay/neuter dogs and cats.



Qualification Guidelines:

- You must permanently reside in Truckee, Sierra County, Eastern Placer County or Eastern Nevada County. **(Sierra County residents can use Plumas Vet in Beckwourth, CA if unable to transport pets to Truckee.)**
- For income based programs, your total household income level must be at or below the Nevada County median income level for your household size. After submitting your completed application and vaccination records, you will be contacted regarding your qualification status.

Additional Information:

- Each voucher is good for one spay or neuter surgery only. Fees for additional procedures, tests or other administrative costs are your responsibility. **You must check with the veterinarian regarding additional expenses when you make your appointment. Different vets will have different requirements.**
- Because of age or illness, some animals may not be appropriate candidates for spaying or neutering. **You should consult with a veterinarian about the suitability of your pet for surgery.** All animals must be current on required vaccinations (listed on the application) prior to surgery.
- All surgery, including spay/neuter surgery, can have risks. **Complications, including injury or death of the animal can occur.** It is your responsibility to talk to your veterinarian about this prior to your appointment.
- **Low cost and free microchip implantation is offered during surgery** to help increase your chances of finding your pet should s/he get lost without their collar or identification.

Your fees:

- **Cats: \$40**
- **Dogs: \$60**
- **Microchipping (recommended): \$15**
- **FREE Spay/Neuter & Microchip Services are available for qualifiers listed on application**

How to Participate:

Complete the attached application and mail it or bring it with your **vaccine records and payment of fees** to: Humane Society of Truckee-Tahoe (CSN Program) – 10961 Stevens Lane, Truckee, CA 96161

CSN surgery appointments at the shelter are scheduled on Tuesday's, and performed by the Humane Society's vet, Dr. Mike Ryan, DVM. These spots fill up quickly so there will usually be a wait.

PLEASE PLAN ACCORDINGLY. If your pet is in heat or pregnant, the additional costs associated with the surgery will be the owner's responsibility. Please speak with our veterinarian about these fees and your options.

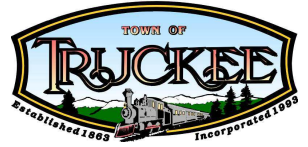
