

FREE Pit Bull/Chihuahua Spay/Neuter Program

Qualification Guidelines & Information:

- You must permanently reside in Truckee, Sierra County, Eastern Placer County or Eastern Nevada County.
- Determining whether your dog is a Pit Bull/Chihuahua/Mix will be at the sole discretion of our staff. Documentation of breed history can be provided, but the final decision will be made by staff.
- All surgery, including spay/neuter surgery, can have risks. Complications, including injury
 or death of the animal can occur. It is your responsibility to talk to our veterinarian about
 this prior to your appointment.
- Fees for additional procedures, tests or other administrative costs are your responsibility.
 You must check with our veterinarian regarding additional expenses when you make your appointment.
- Because of age or illness, some animals may not be appropriate candidates for spaying or neutering. You should consult with your veterinarian about the suitability of your pet for surgery. All animals must be current on required vaccinations (listed on the application) at least 10-14 days prior to surgery.
- FREE microchip implantation is offered during surgery to help increase your chances of finding your pet should s/he get lost without their collar or identification.

Your Fees:

- Spay/Neuter Surgery: FREE
- Optional Microchipping (recommended): FREE

How to Participate:

Complete the attached application and mail it or bring it with vaccination records to: Humane Society of Truckee-Tahoe CSN Program – 10961 Stevens Lane, Truckee, CA 96161

Spay/Neuter surgery appointments are scheduled on **ONE THURSDAY PER MONTH** by appointment only. These spots fill up quickly so there will be a wait. PLEASE PLAN
ACCORDINGLY. If your pet is in heat or pregnant, the additional costs associated with the surgery will be the owner's responsibility. Please speak with our veterinarian about these fees and your options.

Surgeries will be performed by the Humane Society's vet, Dr. Mike Ryan, DVM at our shelter facility located at 10961 Stevens Lane in Truckee.
