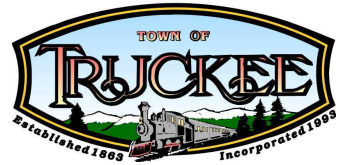

## Community Spay/Neuter Program

The Community Spay/Neuter Program is a subsidized program to spay/neuter dogs and cats.



### Qualification Guidelines:

- You must permanently reside in Truckee, Eastern El Dorado County, Eastern Nevada County, Eastern Placer County, Incline Village, Sierra County, or South Lake Tahoe from Glenbrook to Meyers.
- For the income based low-cost program, your total household income level must be at or below the median income level for your county, for your household size. \*Income based surgeries for Truckee and North Lake Tahoe residents take place at the shelter clinic in Truckee. Income based surgeries for all other residents take place at the nearest participating Veterinary Hospital.
- We invite feral & community cat caretakers to alter cats under their care free of charge through our Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program. \*TNR surgeries for all residents take place at the nearest participating Veterinary Hospital.
- We offer free spay and neuter services to all local Chihuahua and pit bull type dogs, and we welcome US Service Members and Veterans from any branch of the military to spay/neuter their dog or cat free of charge, with a valid military ID or proof of service. \*Free surgeries for all residents take place at the shelter clinic in Truckee.

### Additional Information:

- Each voucher is good for one spay or neuter surgery only. Fees for additional procedures, tests or other administrative costs are your responsibility. **You must check with the veterinarian regarding additional expenses when you make your appointment.**
- Because of age or illness, some animals may not be appropriate candidates for spaying or neutering. **You should consult with your veterinarian about the suitability of your pet for surgery.**
- All surgery, including spay/neuter surgery, can have risks. **Complications, including injury or death of the animal can occur.** It is your responsibility to talk to your veterinarian about this prior to your appointment.
- Low cost and free microchip implantation is offered during surgery to help increase your chances of finding your pet should s/he get lost without their collar or identification.

### Your fees:

- **Cats: \$40**
- **Dogs: \$60**
- **Microchipping (recommended): \$15**
- **FREE Spay/Neuter & Microchip Services are available for qualifiers listed on application**

### How to Participate:

Complete the attached application and mail it or bring it with your vaccine records and payment of fees to Humane Society of Truckee-Tahoe (CSN Program) – 10961 Stevens Lane, Truckee, CA 96161

**PLEASE PLAN ACCORDINGLY: If your pet is in heat or pregnant, has cryptorchidism, or requires additional tests or procedures, the costs associated with them will be your responsibility. Your pet must be current on required vaccinations. Appointments fill up quickly so there will usually be a wait.**
