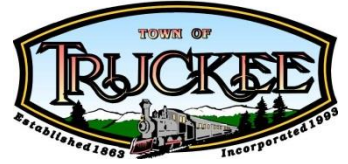




Community Discount Spay/Neuter **Free Military/Veteran's Program**

Qualification Guidelines:

- You must permanently reside in Truckee, Sierra County, Incline Village, Eastern El Dorado County, Eastern Placer County, Eastern Nevada County, or South Lake Tahoe, from Glenbrook to Meyers.
- You must provide valid US military ID or proof of service in order to make your pet's appointment.
- Your pet **must be current on required vaccinations (listed on this application)** at least 10-14 days prior to surgery.

Additional Information:

- The Humane Society of Truckee-Tahoe and Town of Truckee have combined forces to invite US Service Members and Veterans from any branch of the military to spay/neuter their dog or cat FREE of charge, with valid proof of service. If you served in the active military service and were separated under any condition other than dishonorable, you qualify.
- This invitation is good for up to 2 pets.
- Fees for additional procedures, tests or other administrative costs are your responsibility. You must check with our veterinarian regarding additional expenses when you make your appointment.
- Because of age, illness, or other factors, some animals may not be appropriate candidates for spaying or neutering through this program. **You should consult with your veterinarian about the suitability of your pet for surgery.**
- All surgery, including spay/neuter surgery, can have risks. Complications, including injury or death of the animal can occur. It is your responsibility to talk to your veterinarian about this prior to your appointment.
- Low cost microchip implantation is offered during surgery to help increase your chances of finding your pet should s/he get lost without their collar or identification.

- **Dogs: FREE**
- **Optional Microchipping (recommended): \$15**

Free Military pet surgeries are performed at the shelter facility by appointment only. These spots fill up quickly so there will be a wait. **PLEASE PLAN ACCORDINGLY. If your pet is in heat or pregnant, the additional costs associated with the surgery will be the owner's responsibility. Please speak with our veterinarian about these fees and your options.**

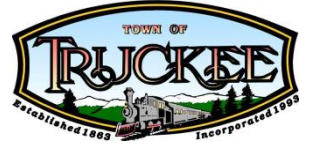
